An ELIM Retreat is a six day gathering of Christian global workers for the purposes of debriefing, personal spiritual assessment/renewal, and pastoral care.

Barnabas International (www.barnabas.org), the parent organization for ELIM Retreat Ministries, exists to provide spiritual care and encouragement to global workers in a variety of ways.

One way that Barnabas serves global workers is by offering 6 day renewal retreats through ELIM Retreat Ministries. These retreats are available to a broad definition of “global workers” which can include pastors (expatriate and national), sending agency staff, and missionaries.

The mission of ELIM Retreat Ministries is to provide places and occasions for the spiritual debriefing, spiritual renewal, and pastoral care of the global worker. We believe that strengthened and encouraged Christian workers result in more fruitful and effective Kingdom work.

Editorial: Divorce: tension between theory & practice in member care

Divorce: tension between theory & practice in member care

Member Care is a fairly new discipline that is still budding. It has been a broad practice for around 30 years. Member Care draws strength from its parent disciplines of Intercultural Studies/Missiology, Ministry Leadership, and Psychology. The theory of Member Care has developed slowly within each parent discipline while practice has dominated the field of Member Care. Theory is important because it gives structure and depth to practice. Theory instructs practice and increases the effectiveness of care giving. Without the accumulative knowledge of theory, the potential for poor care is high. Naturally, the question arises, why has practice flourished and theory slowed? Let us look at a few causal factors.

Member Care came onto the Intercultural Studies/Missiology sphere at a time when theory was being devalued. Standard practice in the field of missions, prior to 1990, was for cross-cultural workers to have entry education requirements of 4 or 6 years of Biblical Studies and Intercultural Studies. The 1990's brought the emphasis that 'education is good, but not necessary in the field of Biblical Studies and Intercultural Studies'. A degree in Business Administration was the preferred training for a prospective pastor or cross-cultural worker. Mission organizations filled the knowledge gap by intensifying pre-field training programs. This shift brought an emphasis on practice over theory.

Secondly, Member Care is a new discipline. Does the newness of the discipline and the related establishment of its processes create the slow development of theory? A possibility! Currently there are numerous books being published in Member Care and academic training is growing. These are positive signs that theory is growing in emphasis.

The verdict is out on whether there is a divorce between theory & practice in Member Care. Much will depend upon the leaders in Member Care and how they instruct the next generation of Member Care workers.
