Editorial: Contact with no Connection

Technology has changed the way in which we communicate with and relate to each other. Things that could not even be imagined of a generation ago are routinely possible today, especially in communication, travel, access to information.....OK google, Ask Siri, Cortana, M....

The width and speed of communication have increased but often without relational depth. Relationships in general tend to be superficial and often task oriented. I contact you if I have "business" to do with you, if not I don't. This tends to happen even in so called mission "teams" and "communities". While it is not possible to be closely connected to a large number of people, it is a challenge in today's world even to be part of a small community that is real and authentic. (Persons with whom I can have coffee with at short notice, who can see and read my body language, whose hand I can shake, who is willing to listen, who cares, who is willing to give time even when I am not part of their "project"). This has huge implications for our overall well being, emotional and mental health and our spiritual life. This has member care implications. It gets magnified and multiplied when we serve cross

culturally.

It takes time to invest in and develop relationships. It involves trust, humility and vulnerability. Sometimes it is easier to just get on with the "project" or the "mission" rather than bother about relationships - A convenient approach, but not a Christ like approach.

May we reflect upon our relationships and seek to be an interconnected body rather than a bowl of marbles which have contact with each other but no connection.
